## Prospect welcomes new CEO & looks forward to working in partnership

Prospect has welcomed the new CEO Allison Kirkby whose formal arrival was heralded by the Q3 results.

Prospect National Secretary John Ferrett was quoted in the Sunday Times noting that as headline pay for 2024 has been agreed, the union looks forward to a period of comparative stability. Regular reorganisations and changes of location in recent times have too often distracted from the key focus of delivering results.

Analyst commentary underlined that an evolutionary rather than a revolutionary approach is expected from the new CEO with a focus on EE, which may face competition from a Vodafone/Three link-up and the continued role out of fibre.

## Performance

Annual performance reviews are starting to get underway. There have been some tweaks which have been fully discussed with Prospect and some changes made.

Performance is now reflected in bonus not core pay. Crucially key safeguards previously negotiated with Prospect remain firmly in place. There is no pre-determined distribution of markings and if there are any issues with performance these should have been raised and reviewed well before now.
